

Dear Year 13 student and parent/carer

We hope that you and your families are well. We are writing to confirm our arrangements for A Level results day this year. In response to the renewed lockdown measures, we are required to email A Level and BTEC results to our students using their school email address at 8.00 am on Thursday 13th August. This will be in the form of a PDF document on Bradgate Sixth Formheaded paper. A paper copy of results will also be posted home on the same day. It is imperative that all students check that they can still access their email accounts and that they know their login details <u>before Thursday 9th July</u>. If a student does not remember their login details they must contact the school so that we can reset the password before results day.

Please check the Bradgate Sixth Form website for updates regarding results day and how to access post results services and support. We are still awaiting clarification from Ofqual and JCQ as to how post results services will be operating this year and will publish information as soon as we know.

On results day all students will receive a phone call from either Mrs Johnson, Karen Stirk or another member of the Senior Leadership Team. The purpose of our call will be to find out if you have accepted your university place or if you have secured your apprenticeship/employment position. We will be offering face to face appointments/support if you require help with Adjustment, Clearing or your future pathways.

Universities will receive centre-assessed grades from exam boards before results day and will review your application. If you have exceeded the conditions of your offer you may be eligible for Adjustment.

Adjustment is a chance to reconsider what and where to study whilst still holding your original, first choice university place. If you are eligible for Adjustment you will be advised when you log in to Track on UCAS. We strongly advise you to discuss your plans with one of us before making any final decisions.

If you do not meet the requirements of your conditional offer universities may still be able to accept you onto your chosen course or offer you an alternative course to study with them. If you are unplaced you need to look at the opportunities available to you in Clearing.

Clearing is how universities and colleges fill any places they still have on their courses and from 6th July you can begin to research the courses available in Clearing.
