



Dear Parent/Carer

In light of the current situation we have taken the decision to amend the structure of the school day for Bradgate Sixth Form students from Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November until Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. This is for the following reasons;

- During the lockdown period it is not appropriate for students to leave and re enter site at lunchtime
- The communal spaces for lunch are indoor and this increases the potential for transmission between students
- We want to reduce the number of students leaving the site at the same time (end of the school day)

From Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November until Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December all Year 12 and 13 students will continue to have lessons period 1 to period 4 but will have remote learning for period 5. Bradgate Sixth Form students will be able to leave site at 1.05pm and will be expected to complete work set for their period 5 lesson remotely.

On Fridays students will continue to have sessions with their Progress Mentors from 1.05pm-1.25pm and will be able to leave site after this session as normal.

We would also like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support during this time. We have also been extremely impressed with the focus and determination shown by all students.
